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## MEDICAL ASSISTANCE MAY PAY

for insurance through your employer.

Can members of your family get health insurance through a job? If yes, you **MUST** give your worker information about that insurance. If the state decides the insurance is *cost effective*, the insurance premiums can be paid for family members who are on Medical Assistance.

*“Cost effective” means that it would cost the state less to pay the insurance premiums, co-pays and deductibles, than to have Medical Assistance pay for all of your medical costs. Family members on Medical Assistance **must** enroll in insurance plans that the state decides are cost effective.*

**If you can get insurance through a job, now or in the future, fill out and return these forms.**

We will tell you what the state decides.

- If the insurance is cost effective, the premium will be paid by the state.

OR

- If the insurance is not cost effective, **you may choose to pay the premium yourself. Then, your family will have medical coverage when Medical Assistance ends.**
