




Annual Cash Aid

**Example:** A single parent with one child who is unemployed would receive about \$6,000 per year in benefits. A single parent with one child who earns \$6.25 per hour would have a yearly income of about \$17,000 per year. A single parent with one child who earns \$9.00 per hour would have a yearly income of about \$21,000 per year.

Income Formula for Oceanside CalWORKs, *County of San Diego*  
(How Income is Counted in the TANF Grant)

Income (Gross)  
- Work Deduction (\$225)  
= Net Income

Net Income  
/2 (divided by 2)  
= Income deducted from Grant

Example:

Mary grosses \$1200 for the month. Mary has 2 children and all three are receiving TANF.

\$1200  
- 225  
\$975

\$975  
/2  
487.5 (Income to be deducted from Grant)

Grant for 3 persons = \$723

\$723  
- 487  
\$236

TANF grant for the following 3 months = \$236

Each adult parent/caretaker in the AU must meet one of the following conditions:
Is disabled and receiving:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• SSI/SSP</li> <li>• IHSS</li> <li>• SDI</li> <li>• TWC - Temp Wkrs Comp</li> <li>• TDI - Temp Dis Indem; or</li> </ul>
Is a non-needy non-parent caretaker.
