SUPPORTIVE SERVICES AGREEMENT

I understand that Work First participants are eligible for supportive services on an as needed basis, pending the availability of funds. Policy for the eligibility of supportive services can change at the discretion of the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Growth and/or the Detroit Workforce Development Department.

I also understand that I must participate the required number of hours in my scheduled activity, i.e., job search, classroom training, and/or employment. **I will forfeit my eligibility for supportive services if I am not participating at the time the check is received or I'm in non-compliance for any of the following reasons:**

- Exhibit disruptive behavior that prevents other participants from pursuing their Work First assignments;
- Threaten to or physically abuse MWA staff, other participants, employees, or project staff;
- Was employed and quit a job, was fired for misconduct or absenteeism, or voluntarily reduce hours of employment without good cause;
- Fail or refuse to appear for a job interview;
- Refuse a bona fide offer of employment; or
- Refuse additional hours of employment up to 40 hours per week.
