Rehab Option Services / Minnesota

"Enable a recipient to retain stability and functioning if the recipient is at risk of losing significant functionality or being admitted to a more restrictive service setting without these services; and

Instruct, assist, and support a recipient in areas such as medication education, monitoring, basic living & social skills, mental illness symptom management, household management, employment-related, or transitioning to community living."

Establishing Medical Necessity for a Rehabilitative Service



A serious mental illness...

where symptoms are impairing functioning

Individual Treatment Plan (ITP) "The Action Plan"

Recovery Vision/Outcome: A statement that describes what the person would like to see happen in their future life, which is not happening now.

Rehabilitation Goal: Describes the targeted area for change & the person's desired outcome.

Objective: A small "forward" step linked to the Rehabilitation Goal which can be attained in 3-6 months.

Interventions: What the ARMHS staff will do specific to the person's use of a skill or ability needed to attain their objective. Uses "Action Verbs" to describe how the person will learn or generalize the skill or ability needed in a specific role or setting.


