

OFA Peer TA Technical Assistance Review Criteria

1. The extent to which the technical assistance requested is likely to move TANF participants from welfare to work, self-sufficiency, and family stability.
2. The degree to which the area of requested technical assistance is related to TANF priorities:
 - a. Provide assistance to needy families so that children may be cared for in their own homes, or in the homes of relatives;
 - b. End of the dependence of needy parents on government benefits by promoting job preparation, work, and marriage;
 - c. Prevent and reduce the incidence of out-of-wedlock pregnancies and establish annual, numerical goals for preventing and reducing the incidence of these pregnancies, and;
 - d. Encourage the formation and maintenance of two-parent families.
3. The degree to which the requested technical assistance methods foster information exchange among States, counties, and communities.
4. The extent to which the technical assistance requested may have value for other States or programs.
5. The cost-effectiveness of the requested technical assistance.
