Organizational Background

Full Circle Exchange is an innovative non-profit social enterprise dedicated to empowering women in the U.S. and around the world to rise above poverty through training, education, and economic opportunities.

Job Readiness Training Program

Providing Stepping Stones To Self Sufficiency

- The Full Circle Exchange holistic Job Readiness Training Program helps refugees and women in transition reclaim their lives by providing stepping stones to self-sufficiency in a safe and supporting environment.
- Full Circle Exchange works in collaboration with each agency to pre-screen and select candidates that are the best fit for the program. We conduct pre and post assessments to identify key areas to focus on for short-term and long-term success.

Overcoming Barriers To Employment

- Full Circle Exchange provides a 3-6 month holistic program that integrates job school and vital enrichment opportunities in a validating environment where women can grow, learn, and overcome barriers to employment.
- Structured job readiness training program occurs within the context of our on-site non-profit social enterprise through the production of handcrafted greeting cards, packaging of gourmet chocolate and coffee, gift boxes, jewelry, accessories, and other items.
- The program is broken down into approximately 25 hours of paid job school and 15 hours of vital enrichment classes.

Reclaiming Their Lives

- Our aim is to lower the barriers of employment and stabilize the lives of women refugees by providing the skills and support needed to enter into entry-level positions, upwardly-mobile employment, and educational pathways, helping them advance towards living-wage employment, and self-sufficiency.
- Since the launch of our Job Readiness Training Program in January 2014, Full Circle Exchange has successfully graduating over 150 women refugees from 10 different countries (99% graduated the program and approximately 78% have transitioned to full-time/part-time employment in the formal sector).

Pathway To Empowerment

Through a multifaceted approach, we work with each woman to create a pathway to empowerment that leads to self-reliance. The program includes four main pillars.

1. Transitional Income

- Part-time transitional job (3-6 month program)
- A dignified job that promotes self-esteem and confidence
- A flexible work schedule that takes into account family obligations, transportation challenges, and partnered efforts towards permanent job placement
- A supportive, safe, and validating environment where they can grow, learn, and overcome barriers which otherwise would have been too great to overcome

2. Job Readiness Training And Job Placement

- Stabilization/removing employment barriers
- Provide soft skills that are lacking in entry-level applicants
- Training and production of greeting cards, and gift boxes
- Quality control and time-management training
- Warehouse, inventory, sales, and merchandising training
- Resume building & interview training
- Job place etiquette
- Team building, goal-setting, and problem solving
- Job fairs and direct one-on-one help with permanent placement in community
