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# What is Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC)?

A federal tax benefit to help low and moderate income workers increase their financial stability.

- □ Largest Federal anti-poverty program
- □ Reduces taxes for workers
- □Supplements wages
- ☐ Encourages individuals to work
- ☐ Fully refundable credit

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# Who Might Miss Out on the EITC?

- **■** Workers not required to file returns -- In 2011:
  - \$19,000 for a married couple
  - \$12,200 for head of household
  - \$9,500 for a single filer
- Welfare recipients entering the workforce
- Family members with disabilities
- Workers becoming eligible due to reduced earnings, or loss of employment
- Newly divorced or separated custodial parents
- New parents
  - Foster
  - Adoptive

### Families Who Can Claim the EITC & CTC

- ☐ Married and unmarried parents
  - ■Step-parents
- ☐ Grandparents, great-grandparents
  - ☐ Grandparent with child and grandchild
- ☐ Aunt or uncle
- □ Older brother or sister
  - □Step-brother or step-sister
  - ■Half-brother or half-sister
- ☐ Foster and adoptive parents\*

#### **How Much Can Workers Earn and Qualify for the EITC?**

#### For Work in 2011:

Number of children:	Earned Income less than:	EITC up to:
3 or more children	\$43,998	\$5,751
2 children	\$40,964	\$5,112
1 child	\$36,052	\$3,094
No children	\$13,660	\$464

- Income limits for married workers are \$5,080 higher than these amounts.
- Investment income cannot exceed \$3,150.

#### **How Much Can Workers Earn and Qualify for the CTC?**

# Workers who earned *more than* \$3,000 in 2011 can receive a CTC refund.

Modified Adjusted Gross Income less than:	Filing status:
\$110,000	Married Filing Joint
\$75,000	Single or Head of Household
\$55,000	Married filing separately

The CTC is worth *up to* \$1,000 for each qualifying child.

# The High Cost of Commercial Tax Preparation

- ☐ When it is time to file a tax return, many workers seek help from a commercial tax preparer.
- □ Average fees range from \$85 \$120 for e-filing.

# **Options for Free Tax Return Preparation**

- Traditional Volunteer Site
- Virtual VITA/TCE
- FAST (Free Assisted Self Service Tax Preparation)

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# What are barriers to access traditional VITA/TCE sites?

- Taxpayer and partners are located in remote rural areas
- Lack of certified volunteers
- Taxpayers with Disabilities
- Transportation barriers
- Language barriers
- Hours of Availability

#### **Virtual VITA/TCE Sites**

- Challenges that prevent site from becoming operational:
  - Lack of sufficient certified volunteers
  - Lack of computer, equipment and/or space
- DVD is available with specific examples
- Two Components:
  - -Intake Site
  - Preparation Site

# FAST (Free Assisted Self Service Tax Preparation)

- In coordination with the Free File Alliance:
  - H&R Block
  - Turbo Tax
  - Tax Slayer
- Site is provided specific url for each of these providers to load on computer

SCHEDULE TORON Labor

#### **Benefits**

- Reduce lines at peak times at VITA/TCE sites
- Increase options for taxpayers
- Sites get credit for returns prepared
- Taxpayers may need a little help initially, but build confidence to file on their own next year.

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# Sample Student Benefit

- Single Parent, one child, \$18K income and pays tuition and fees:
- \$2,790 Refundable EITC
- \$1,000 Refundable Education Credit
- \$3,790 Total Refund

- \$3,770 Federal Pell Grant (avg. award)
- \$7,560 Total Benefit

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
