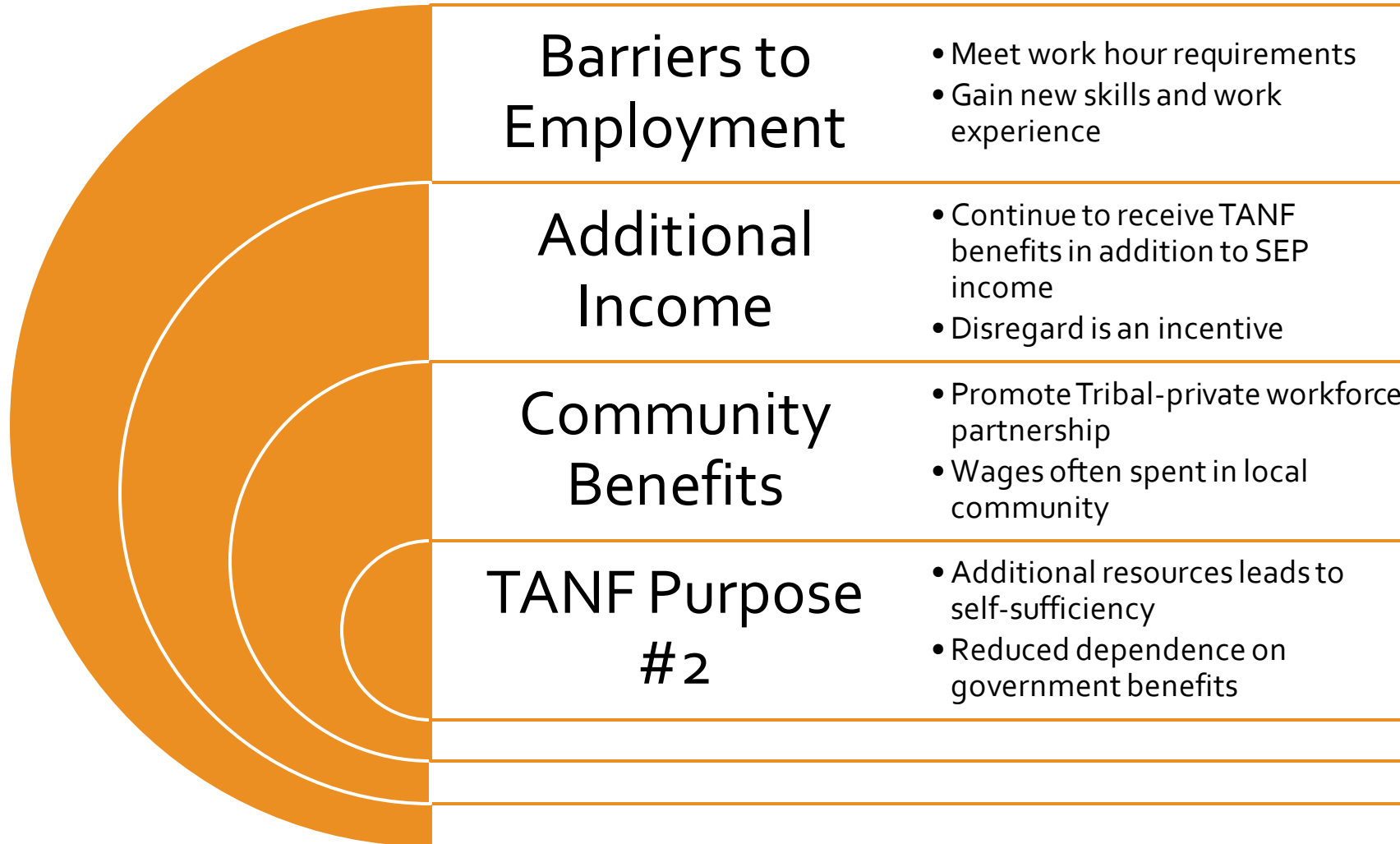


Wage Subsidies

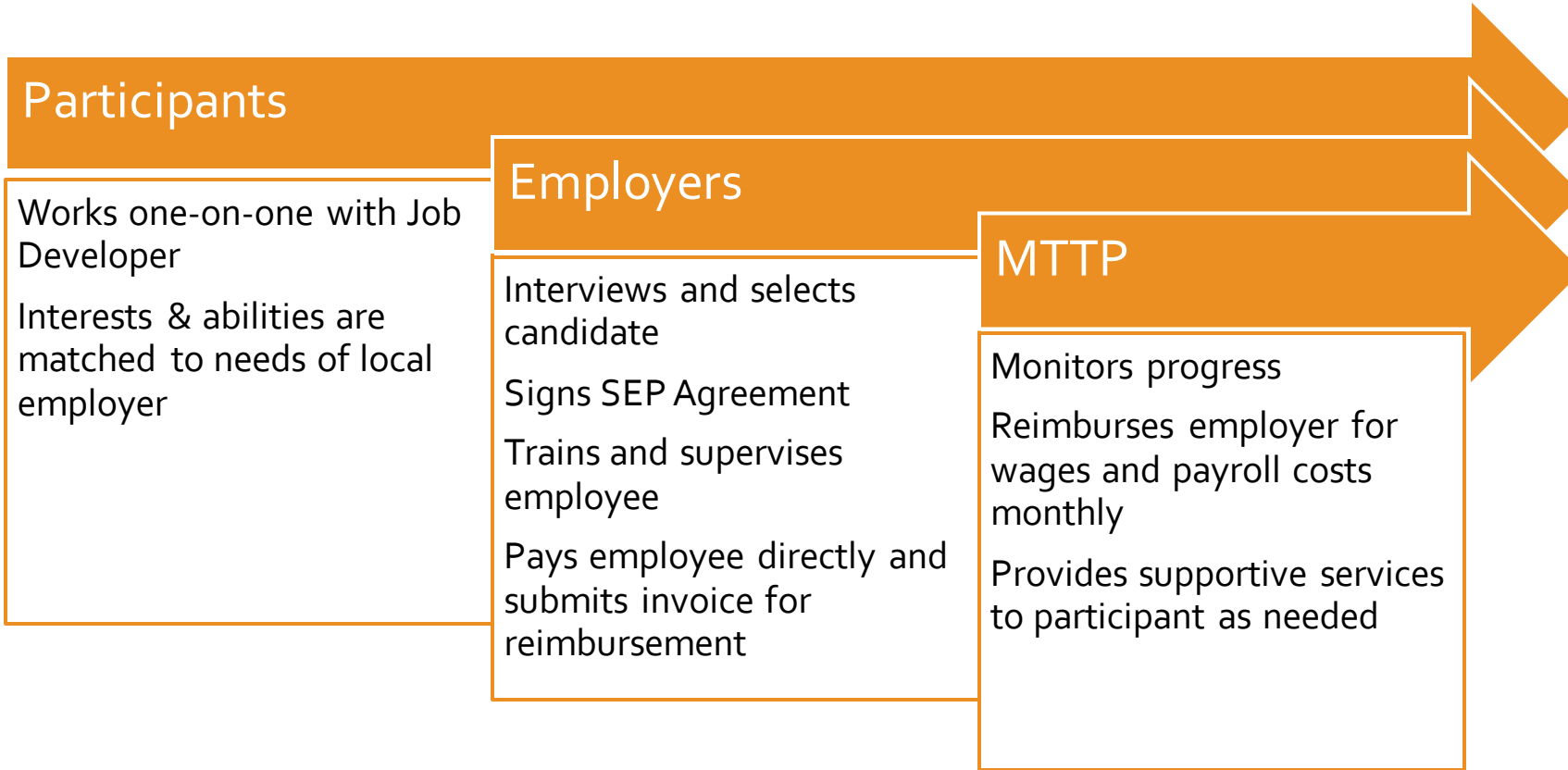
- Participants can work up to 40 hours per week under the SEP Agreement for six months
- Employers are reimbursed for 50% of employee wages, payroll taxes and Worker's Compensation Insurance
- Reimbursement for background checks or A/D screening

How Does the SEP Partnership Work?



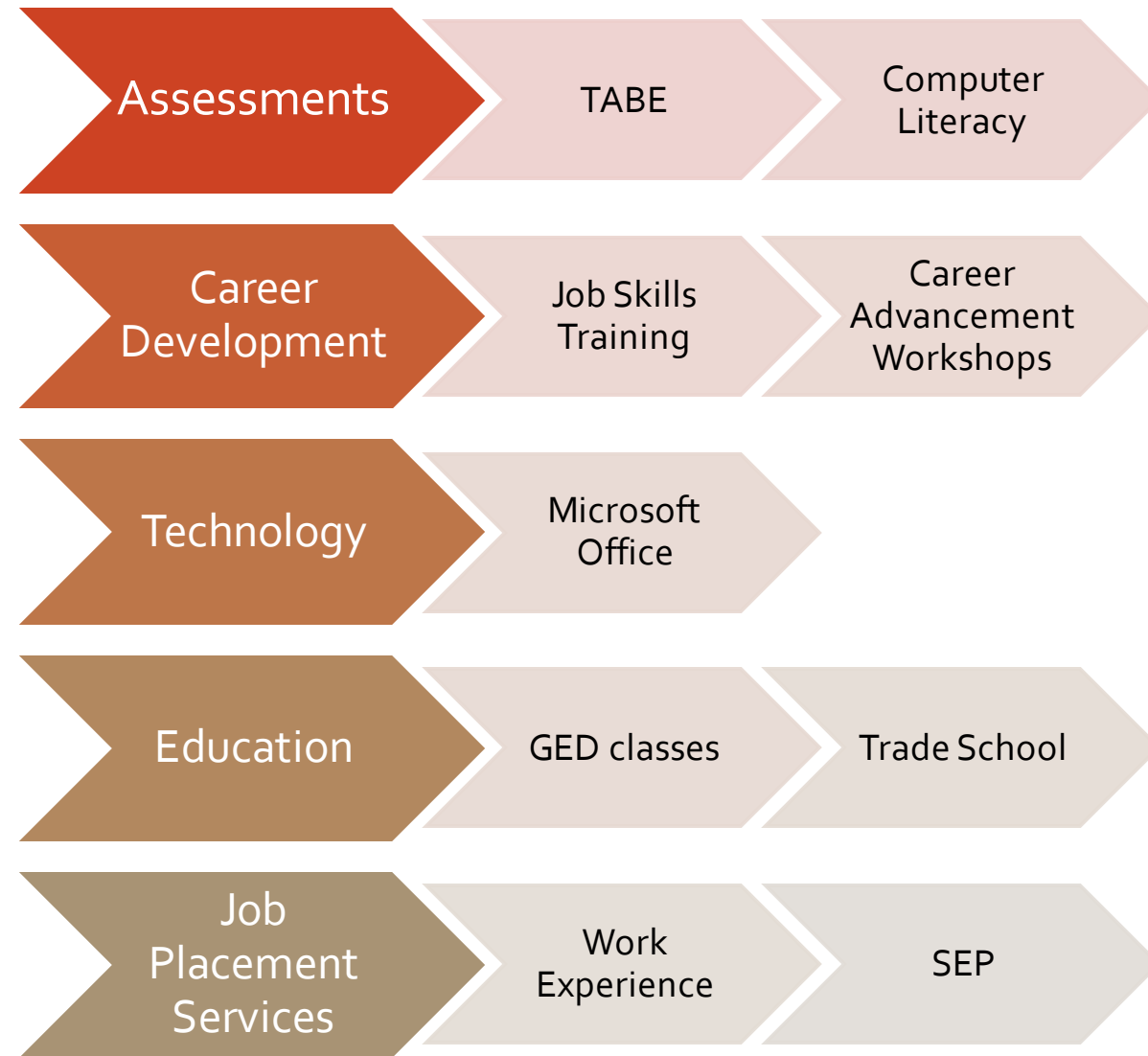
➤ Employer is encouraged to retain the participant at the end of the subsidy period

MTTP Participant Eligibility

- TANF (cash assistance) case types only
- Time on aid, compliance with Personal Responsibility Plan considered
- Limited to one placement in a 12 month period
- Must complete career advancement workshop or job readiness activity



Job Development Services



Available Supportive Services

- Interview clothing, work related clothing and/or uniforms
- Tools and equipment required by employer
- Child care
- Transportation (fuel)
- Professional license fees
- Case management supported by Job Developer (i.e. interview prep)



Employer Eligibility

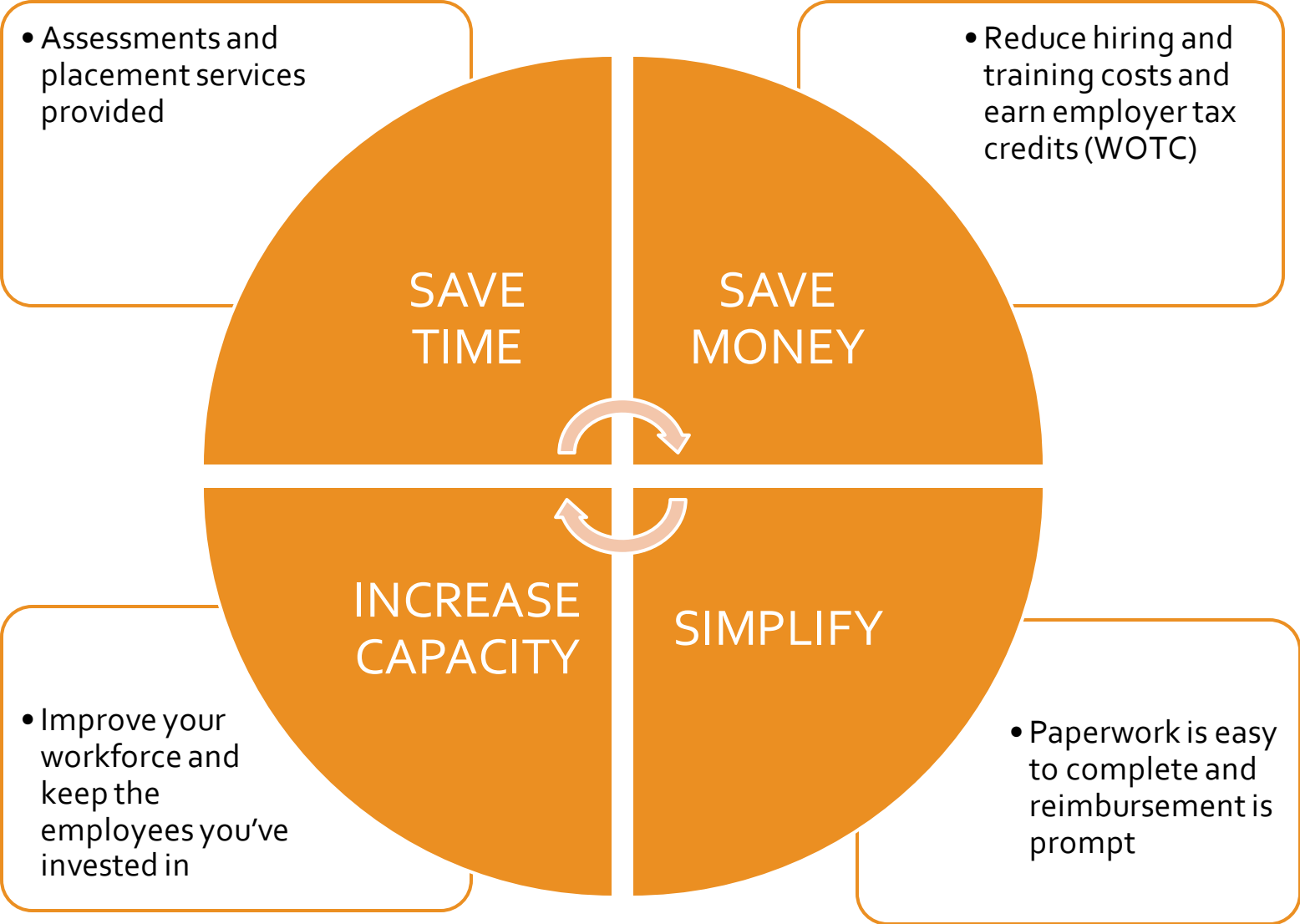


- Must be willing to train, supervise and evaluate employee performance
- Must provide a job description and enter into an agreement with MTTP
- Must certify position is open and will not displace a current employee in accordance with 45 CFR 286.110
- Must maintain and report actual hours of worked performed and wages earned monthly
