- Focuses on preventative services and referrals to assist families in addressing challenges and barriers.
- Focus on preventing children from entering into care.
- Focus on bridging the gap between TANF and ICW programs.
- Facilitates Family Wraparound Meetings.
- Conducts home visits, family assessments, and assists with home studies as needed.
