# CITC's FY21 Impact

***13,000 participants served through integrated services***

---

- **1,202** served in Alaska's People
  - **101** employees meeting CITC's definition of Alaska Native/American Indian household were recruited to work for CITC and its subsidiaries
- **2,350** served in Recovery Services
  - **15,500** individuals were served through **68** outreach events
- **1,100** families served with COVID financial Assistance in Employment and Training Services
  - **629** individuals employed with 169 moving from temporary assistance to employment
  - **\$10.38 per hour** average wage increase for participants
- **1,029** youth participants served through CITC's Education & Innovation services
  - **97%** graduation rate
  - **10,480** hours in combined STEM-based projects in the Fab Lab serving 671 students in the classrooms.
- **450** served through Child & Family
  - **81%** Average Reunification Rate
