Discussion Questions

- How do you plan to train TANF front line staff about the new CCDF requirements and coordination opportunities?
- What challenges or opportunities do you see with the Minimum 12-Month Eligibility and/or Continued Assistance before Termination requirements?
- Do you intend to pursue the recommendation for cross-enrollment and other streamlining and alignment strategies for multiple benefit programs?
- How are you coordinating services for vulnerable and underserved populations?
- Knowing that CCDF/ACF has emphasized engaging rural communities, prioritized services for families experiencing homelessness, and highlighted Two-Generation Approaches, what are your thoughts on working with your TANF or CCDF partners in order to achieve your shared goals?
- How have aligned data systems supported families and streamlined eligibility determination and authorizations for services?
