





Developing and using your TTCW logic model for systems change

Resources for developing and using your TTCW logic model to identify key program components; articulate measurable outputs and outcomes; track progress; and make informed decisions about whether activities, services, and policies are being implemented as intended and resulting in your expected organizational and client outcomes



Data Collection

Planning for data collection and collecting data

Resources for data collection and collecting data resources: for understanding the value of data collection, preparing for data collection, and collecting high-quality data



Using Stories

Collecting and using stories in program research and dissemination

Resources for collecting stories, along with guidance and examples of how to use stories in program research and dissemination efforts, including types of products that can be generated

Resources for planning and developing data sharing agreements with your TTCW partners to increase information sharing for the purpose of increasing service coordination



Resources for outcome evaluation, for evaluating all types of TTCW program outcomes including outcomes related to collaboration





Resources for thinking about sustainability of your TTCW program and developing your sustainability plans and actions




