# Chippewa Cree Tribal TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families) Program

### • History:

- Chippewa Cree Tribal Business Committee approved by resolution the contract with the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services for the Tribal Family Assistance Program on October 21, 2004.
- Total number of cases meeting the FFY 1994 Indian families funding eligibility criteria for 369 cases with the funding formula block grant of \$1,258,657 federal and \$335,182 state.
- Program director; 4 case managers; fiscal/admin/IT; intake/office manager; records; work readiness; family activities coordinator; security/quality assurance.
- Located 30 miles south of Havre, Montana; closest city Great Falls, Montana 100 miles west. The Chippewa Cree Tribe is on the Rocky Boy's Reservation and is the smallest Reservation in Montana. The Canadian border is 40 miles north of Havre.


### Cultural activities
