

## **SUCCESS WITH RFP**

We have had a great deal of Success with the Revitalizing Fatherhood Program.

Multiple Fathers in our program have received jobs while attending our fatherhood classes. If they do not have jobs, then they have goals for what they want to do in life and have plans on how they will achieve those goals.

Multiple Fathers in our program enrolled in the Nooksack Tribe's "NACTEP" program. (Native College Program)

We have seen past participants of the Fatherhood Program being more interactive with their children out in the community.

## BARRIERS/SOLUTIONS

- We have had Barriers in the Fatherhood Program.
- Instructors have emergencies that require a workshop or meeting to be cancelled.
- Getting clients to attend our mandatory classes.

Clients to bring in paperwork for their Portfolios.

- Some of our Solutions to the Barriers.
