



- One of the first to elect Self-Governance
- Current membership: 5280
- Confederation of 17+ tribes and bands
- 11-County Service Area
- USDA-15 County Service Area

Siletz Tribal TANF

- TANF Program started1997
- Incorporated under P.L.
 102-477 with DOL, BIA
- Annual TANF funding \$1,150,000
- Operating under a 10year State Funding Agreement.



Siletz USDA Program

- USDA Program started early 1980's
- 15 County service area
- Complete food nutrition program – not supplemental
- Serving 116 families monthly
