


MI TANF Background

Center on Budget and Policy Priorities (CBPP) reports Michigan has the highest 2018 TANF application denial rate

Michigan has the Lowest Percentage of TANF Applications Approved in the Nation

TANF application approval rate for all 50 states and the District of Columbia




Background: Income thresholds

- Only approximately 20% of all cash applications were approved in 2019
- Lower application approval rate than most other states







Iterative & Progressive Analysis



Initial Findings

- Most denials due to Initial Ineligibility
- Income denials are the second most frequent denial type





Analyzing Policy Change: Initial Eligibility

- Idea for icon change came from initial analysis and collaboration
- Subsequent semester Harris students tracked policy change results, building on previous work
- Analysis will continue internally

Few Poor Families With Children Received **TANF, 2019** Number of families with children receiving TANF benefits for every 100 families with children in poverty ← Michigan New Hampshire

Analyzing Policy Change: Income Denials

- 98% of TANF approved families were below 40% FPL
- Income threshold increases were simulated to illustrate the effects on application approval rates and potential budget affects
- The Harris master-level students offered policy recommendations based on the simulations
