A Snapshot of Nevada

- Nevada's TANF program is state-administered through the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services (DWSS).
- We offer benefits and services to needy families with – or expecting – children.
- Nevada's Assistance Programs
 - TANF-NEON is our mandatory work program developed to assist needy parents/caregivers.
 - TANF Child-Only is designed for households that do not have a work-eligible individual.
 - Non-Needy Relative Caregivers
 - Non-Needy Kinship Caregivers
 - Ineligible Non-citizen adult(s) with eligible children
 - Households where the parent is an SSI recipient
 - Fictive Kin
- Our state provides up to 60 months on TANF-NEON as follows:
 - 24 months on assistance / 12 consecutive months off assistance
 - 24 months on assistance / 12 consecutive months off assistance
 - 12 months on assistance
- Our program served approximately 16,000 recipients or an estimated 6,000 households in SFY22.
