

HPOG/ TANF Connection



- All grantees have established a quantifiable projection tied to serving TANF individuals.
 - That projection is the number of TANF recipients that will be enrolled by the program each year that is reasonable given the total number of TANF recipients within the proposed service area.
- Under HPOG 1 we enrolled around 15% TANF
- Goal for HPOG 2 TANF recipient enrollment is 31%
 - Currently at 18%
- HPOG Evaluation, Impact Study, and Random Assignment
