HPOG Impact Study designed to produce rigorous evidence

- Impact refers to the causal effect of HPOG and specific program characteristics
 - Differences in outcomes could be due to different observable or unobservable characteristics (e.g., motivation)
 - Want to compare outcomes for HPOG treatment group to outcomes that would be observed in absence of treatment
- Most rigorous design to produce this evidence is a randomized design
- Impacts reflect the difference the program makes relative to what else is available



HPOG Impact Study uses a randomized evaluation design

- Random assignment for the HPOG Impact Study began in the first grantee in March 2013, 2½ years after grants were funded
- Sample
 - 42 distinct HPOG 1.0 programs operated by 23 non-tribal grantees
 - 13,717 people in study sample
- Random assignment produced impact estimates for
 - Overall impact across programs
 - Impact of three program enhancements

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


Most programs had large contrast in financial and support services

- Need to see contrast in trainings or services available to treatment and control groups to expect any impact
- Tested four domains to assess extent of contrast
 - HPOG-only training courses
 - Preferred access to courses in the community
 - Financial assistance
 - Academic, personal, and family supports
- Largest contrast was in financial assistance and other support services (~75% of programs), rather than access to training (~25% of programs)



Treatment group received more training and services






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
HPOG increased educational progress








HPOG had no detectable impact on employment in Q5






HPOG increased employment in healthcare






HPOG increased access to employerprovided health insurance






HPOG had no detectable impact on TANF receipt

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Key Takeaways

- The overall goal of HPOG is to increase earnings and employment over the long term
- HPOG mostly added financial and support services
- The collection of diverse HPOG programs is increasing educational progress, the first milestone in HPOG's logic model



Key Takeaways

- HPOG also increased employment in healthcare, access to employer-sponsored health insurance, and earnings
- Longer-term follow-up research (at 36- and 72-months) will assess degree to which HPOG "graduates" make further career progress



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
