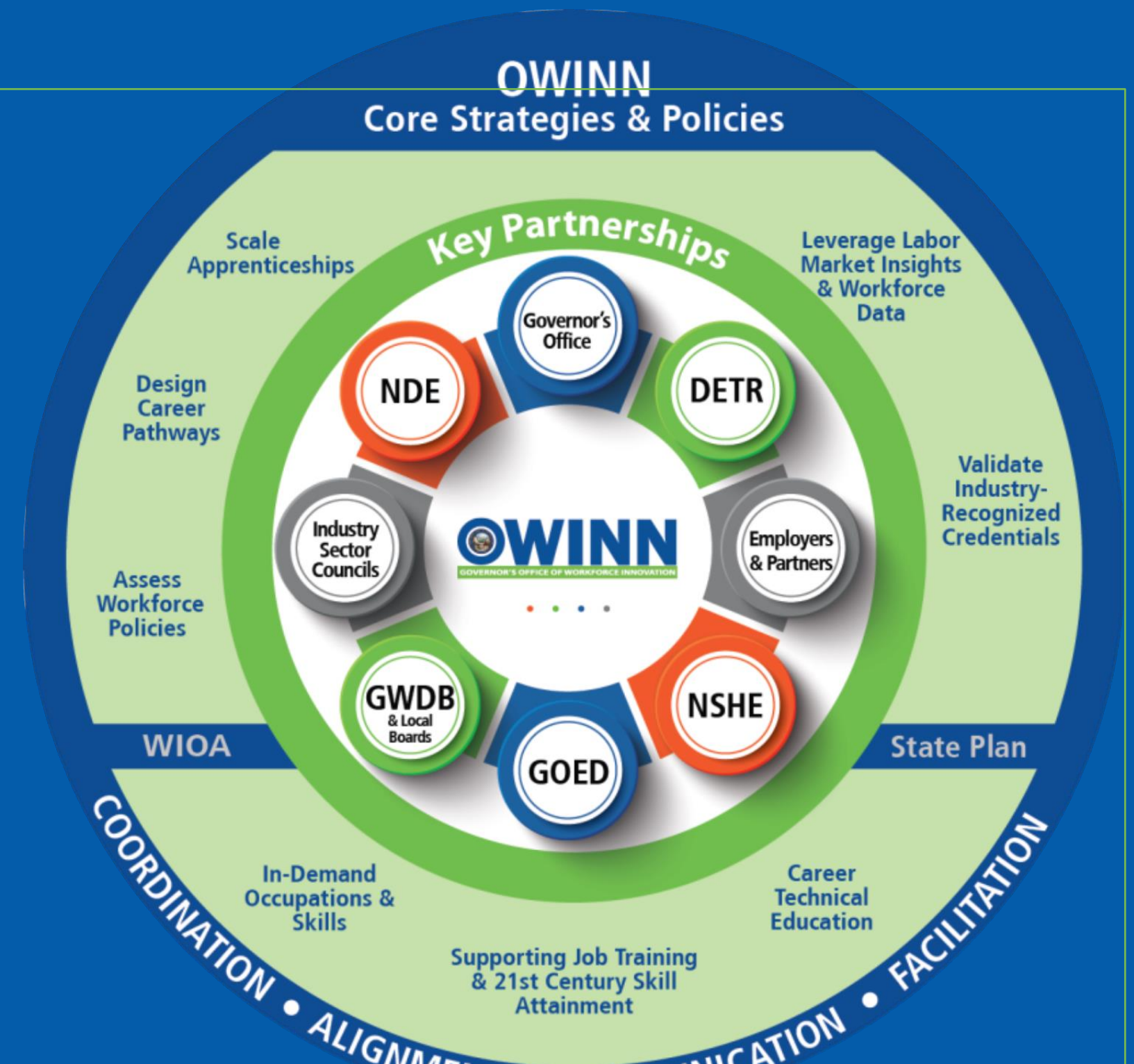



Our Mission:

OWINN helps drive a skilled, diverse, and aligned workforce in the state of Nevada by promoting **cooperation and collaboration** among key public and private entities focused on workforce development.





In addition to the **health toll** that the pandemic has brought to Nevada, **resulting in over 171,159 cases and 2,326 deaths thus far**, the economic fallout of COVID-19 has also been devastating.

Climbing to a historic high of 28.2 percent in April to 12 percent in October, the unemployment rate still remains among the highest in the nation with many Nevadans out of work as cases have begun to spike again.

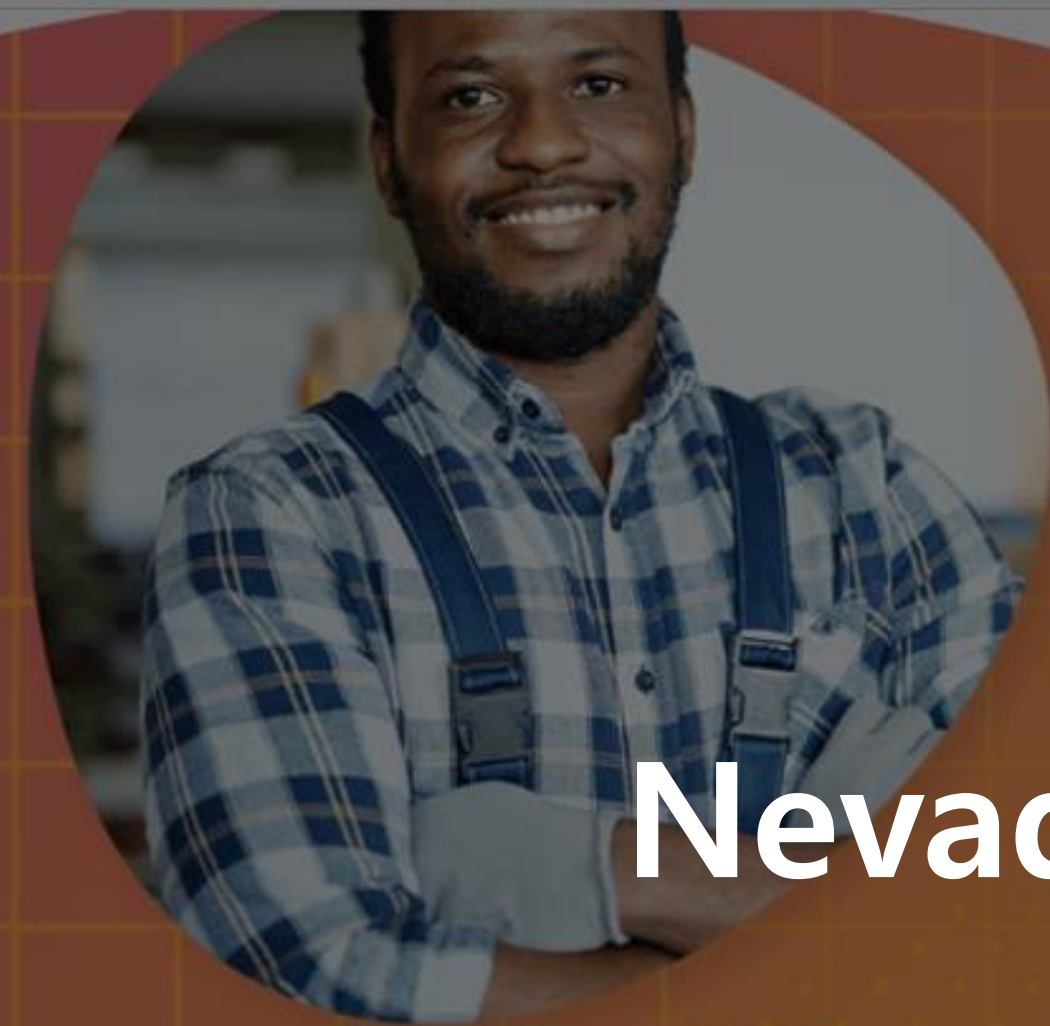
