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### Mental Health Needs

- Major Mental Illness
  - Schizophrenia, Schizoaffective, Bi-Polar Disorder,
     Depression
- Personality Disorders
  - Borderline, Anti-social, Obsessive Compulsive,
     Paranoid Personality
  - Characteristics of Personality Disorders: Distrustful,
     Mood swings, Hard to engage



## **Holistic Assessment**

- Not "What is wrong with you?", rather "What has happened to you?"
- What do you need?
  - MH, SA, health, education, housing
- What do your kids need?
- Know the community resources
  - Mental health access line



#### **Prevalence Data**

- In 2011, there were over 500,000 substantiated reports of child abuse in the United States
  - 78.5% Neglect
  - 17.6 % Physical abuse
  - 9.1% Sexual abuse
  - 9.0% Emotional abuse
  - 2.2% Medical neglect
  - 10.6% Other
  - Many children experienced multiple types of abuse and multiple instances of the same abuse



## Prevalence Data (2)

- A report of child abuse is made every ten seconds.
- More than four children die every day as a result of child abuse.
- More than 90% of juvenile sexual abuse victims know their perpetrator in some way.



## Prevalence Data (3)

- Child abuse occurs at every socioeconomic level, across ethnic and cultural lines, within all religions and at all levels of education.
- About 30% of abused and neglected children will later abuse their own children, continuing the horrible cycle of abuse.
- In at least one study, about 80% of 21 year olds that were abused as children met criteria for at least one psychological disorder.



## Core Values of Trauma-Informed Care

- Safety: Ensuring physical and emotional safety
- <u>Trustworthiness</u>: Maximizing trustworthiness, making tasks clear, and maintaining appropriate boundaries
- Choice: Prioritizing consumer choice and control
- <u>Collaboration</u>: Maximizing collaboration and sharing of power with consumers
- <u>Empowerment:</u> Prioritizing consumer empowerment and skill-building
