

Do not: Make assumptions

Determining the Root Causes

Would s/he feel comfortable pursuing child support if s/he didn't have to meet with the other parent in a private setting?

Would s/he feel comfortable pursuing child support if there was a domestic violence advocate present?

Would s/he feel comfortable pursuing child support if s/he could appear by phone?

Would s/he feel comfortable pursuing child support if the other parent did not have her/his address or other contact information?
