- Goal-setting is individual and participants have equal opportunities for success.

  - Employment Readiness
  - Support Services for Employment
  - Higher Exit Limit
  - Employment Incentive Payments and Reduced Childcare Costs
  - Ongoing Family Coaching

- Revised Policy to Support Two-Parent Families
  - Eliminated Deprivation
  - Unique Living Situations
  - Time Limits
  - Plan Participation

# Reducing Poverty Through Professional Development

- Family Engagement Model
  - Specialized Training for Staff

  - Goal Setting for Strengths and Barriers





### **Jobs Participation Incentive**

- Currently 11,287 two-parent families employed 35 average hours per week
  - Receive \$10 food benefit for continued employment
  - Provides opportunity to engage families





### **Service Delivery Innovations**

- Employment and Training Initiative
  - Local Support Service Projects
  - Community-based Involvement
  - Advocate Community
- Additional Program Funding
  - Housing Stabilization, Food Bank, Child Welfare
