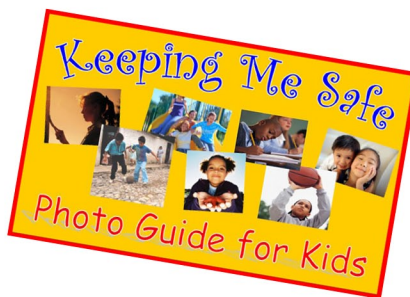


The Drug Endangered Child Training Network is committed to children.
