S.A.F.E. PROJECT

Safety, Advocacy, Finances, and Employment

What is the S.A.F.E. PROJECT?

 A collaborative effort between DCF KS and Catholic Charities Harbor House working to reduce employment barriers for survivors of domestic violence/sexual assault with the ultimate goal of economic independence.

Who do we serve?

- Men or women (and their children) survivors of domestic violence as defined by the state of KS (intimate partner violence)
- Must either be on cash assistance through the state or must complete Within My Reach (healthy relationships class) and meet state guidelines for 100% poverty
- * Must live in 1 of the 25 counties that the Catholic Diocese of Wichita serves

Services Offered by S.A.F.E.

- * Safety planning
 - Individualized safety plans created with each client at initial appointment
 - Address and update safety plan as needed during each follow up
 - Provide tips for how to stay safe in a crisis
- * Career/employment services
 - Resume building
 - Interviewing skills
 - Refer to community partners for appropriate attire for interviewing
 - Assist with job search
 - Assist with educational opportunities
 - Goal planning

Services offered...con't.

Domestic violence/child abuse education

- Provided during work program orientations to TANF recipients
- Continued as needed per request of the client
- Refer to DV education groups in their area
- * Financial literacy
 - Utilize All State DV specific curriculum
 - Online Curriculum Money Smart
 - Dave Ramsey DVD series to help with lifetime financial improvement
 - Refer to community for in-person classes, if requested

- * Medical/psychosocial services
 - Refer for local services

 - Love and Logic
 - Online Parenting Wisely curriculum
