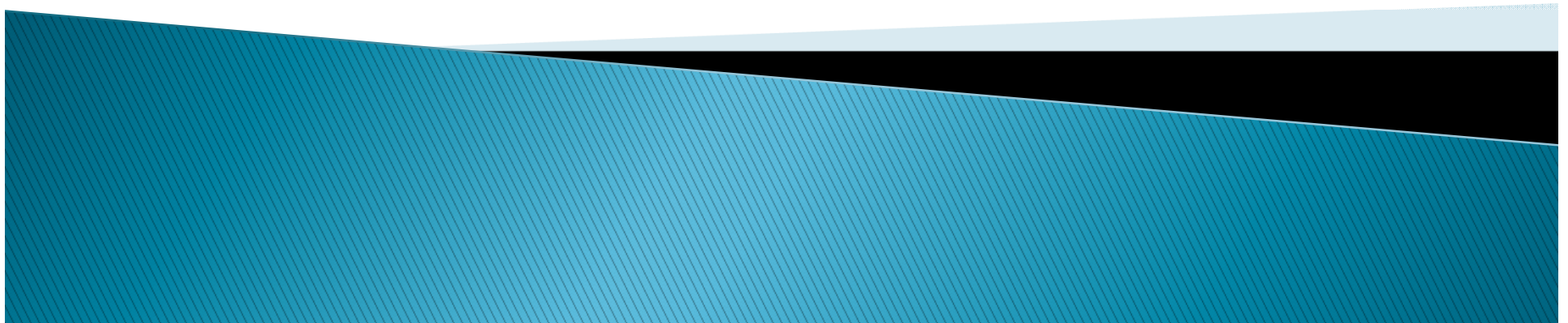




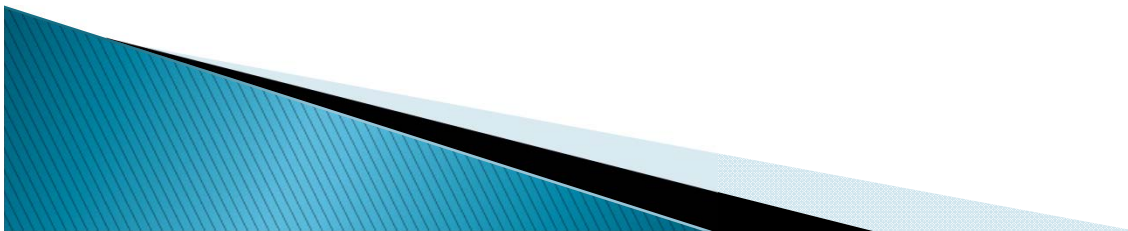

To develop a nursing career ladder that provides academic support and support services to grant participants so at the point of completion they are able to obtain jobs that pay a living wage for a family.

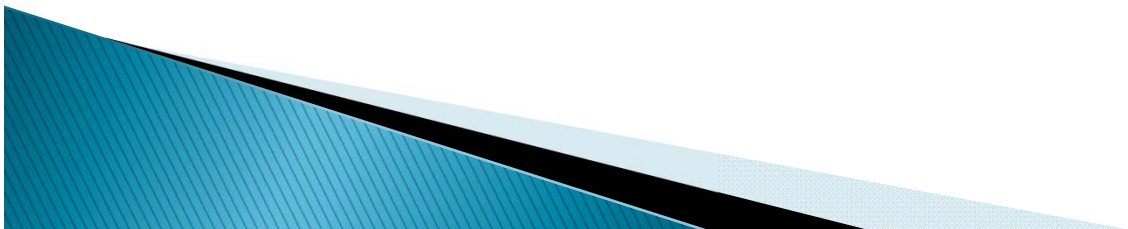


Target Audiences

C. Underemployed

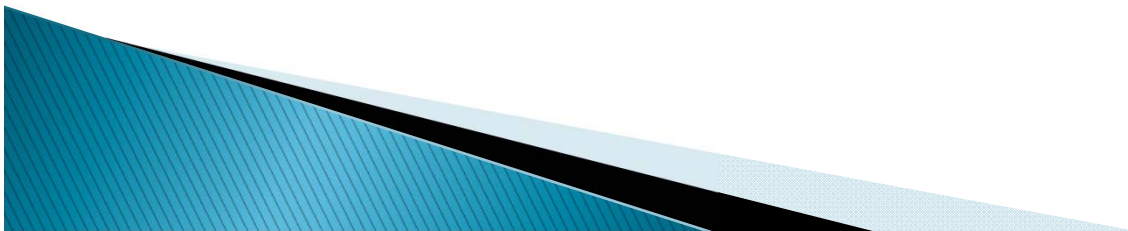
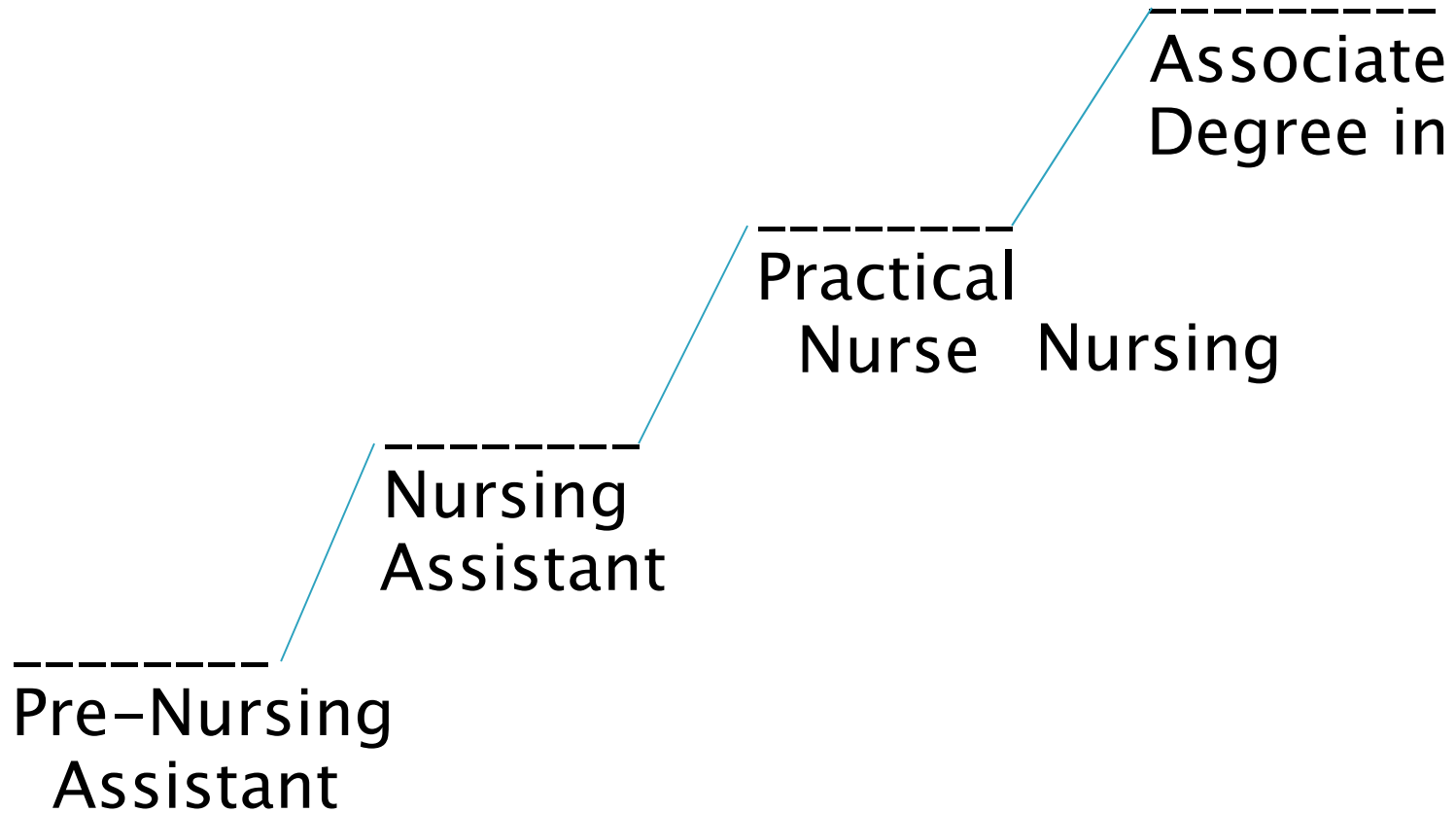


Eligibility for the Grant:

- ▶ Income eligibility
- ▶ US Citizen, be a refugee or be eligible for Public Benefits
- ▶ Successful Caregiver Criminal Background Check

Grant Processes

- ▶ Intake Meeting
- ▶ Sign Student Success Plan
- ▶ Attend a Fiscal Management Session & Develop Individual Budget
- ▶ Encouraged to move up Career Ladder.
- ▶ Referred to Home Health Aid if not able to progress academically.



Role – Collaborations with TANF/WFD

- ▶ Can assist participants with obtaining a more fully developed academic skills evaluation.
- ▶ Can work with them in developing a career pathway to success.
- ▶ Provide support services where TANF leaves off.
- ▶ Assist with job searches/job search skills through relationship with health care institutions.
