

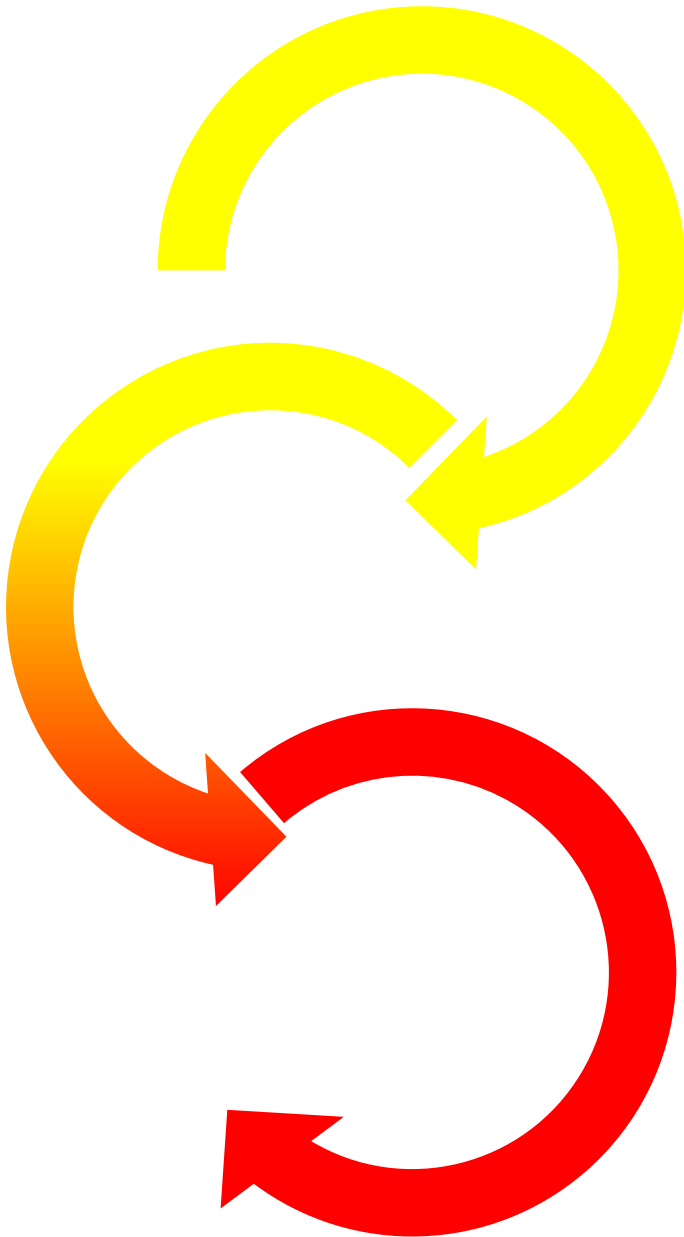

- Motion to Waive Case Manager Conference\*
- File in County where other parent resides.
- Get to Court early, bring a friend or advocate, and let OCS know in advance.
- Submit OCS ticket to BGS notifying them of hearing date & time and request security escort to and from Court.

I would feel comfortable pursuing child support if I could appear for court hearings by phone.

- Motion to Appear by Phone\*\*

I would feel comfortable pursuing child support if I had a domestic violence advocate present.

- Referral to Regional Domestic Violence Advocacy Group

I would feel comfortable pursuing child support if the other parent did not have my address or other contact information.

- Request for Order of Nondisclosure\*\*\*
- Customer Establishment of PO Box
- Safe at Home Program
