

Medical Assistance May Pay

Medical Assistance (MA) may pay for health insurance through your employer.



Can members of your family get health insurance through a job?

If yes, you must give your team information about that insurance. If the state decides that the insurance is cost effective, the insurance premiums can be paid for family members who are on MA.

What does “cost effective” mean?

“Cost effective” means that it would cost the state less to pay the insurance premiums, co-pays and deductibles, than to have the MA pay for all of your medical costs.

Who must enroll in employer-offered health insurance?

Family members on MA must enroll in insurance plans that the state decides are cost effective.

How will I know if my plan is cost effective?

We will tell you what the state decides.

- If the insurance is cost effective, the state will pay the premium.
- If the insurance is **not** cost effective, the state will not pay the premium. You may choose to pay the premium yourself. Then your family will have medical coverage when MA ends.
