Program Description

IE.IDA is a matched savings incentive program for low-income residents who live in Riverside or San Bernardino County.

IE.IDA will match each dollar saved with \$2 placed in a parallel savings account.

Accounts will be opened at one of the five designated holding banks: City National Bank, Citibank, Guaranty Federal Bank, Washington Mutual, or Altura Credit Union. Branches are located throughout Riverside or San Bernardino County.

One of three goals must be selected for savings:

- Educational or vocational pursuit
- Down payment or closing costs for a home purchase
- Small business capitalization

The maximum amount that can be matched for each participant is \$2,000.

You Save	\$2,000
Match Funds Earned	\$4,000
TOTAL FUNDS	\$6,000

Participant selection preference given to:

- Single heads-of-household with one or more children
- Welfare-to-Work recipients

Program Details

Eligibility

- Current TANF participants
- Participants must be a resident of Riverside or San Bernardino County
- Individuals who meet income and net worth guidelines:
 1. Prior year net worth must not exceed \$10,000 excluding the primary residence and one vehicle,
 2. Income less than 200% federal poverty guideline, or
 3. Households eligible for Earned Income Tax Credit.

Household Size	Earned Income
0 Children	\$12,120 or Less
1 Child	\$32,001 or Less
2+ Children	\$36,348 or Less

Requirements

- Participants attend life-skills building workshops including credit counseling, money management, small business start-up, home maintenance, etc., depending upon their savings goal
- Participants must have earned income from a job or self-employment
